





After studying sculpture and economy, he carries out his fashion studies at Central St. Martin's and London College of Fashion.

Then he worked with designers such as Jonathan Saunders, creating his own label, winning the award New Generation (sponsored by Top Shop) four consecutive times. He has showcased his collection in London Fashion Week since 2005.



JORGE VÁZQUEZ

He carries our design studies in Madrid and USA. After working with Inditex, Antonio Pernas, Angel Schlesser and Fun & Basics he presents his first collection at Mercedes-Banz Fashion Week Madrid in 2002, alternating the presentation of his own creations with assignments with brands such as Síntesis and Loewe, collaborating with the latter in the design of the woman prêtà-porter collection in 2006, During this year he creates his own new project JV by Jorge Vazquez inaugurating the first flagship store of his new label in 2012.



JUANA MARTÍN

Commences her career in 1999 after being chosen to represent her province, Córdoba, in the national contest, Young Designers by Smirnoff. In 2005 she becomes the first woman from Andalucia and of gipsy origins that participates in Mercedes-Benz Fashion Week Madrid. She presents her lines of flamenco fashion, swimwear, bridal wear and prêt-à-porter in different fashion weeks such as; MBFWM, SIMOF and Valencia Fashion Week.



RABANEDA

Carried out design studies in the college Arte2 in Madrid and 2010 he creates his first collection, obtaining the award for Best Novel Designer by Valencia Fashion Week. He begins his global projection collaborating with Disney and participating in the fashion week of the Dominican Republic. He markets his collections at the trade shows that take place during the Semaine des Créateurs in Paris and presents his collections during the official calendar of Mercedes-Benz Fashion Week Madrid since 2010.



MARÍA BARROS

Studied fashion design at IED in Milan, where she accomplished her thesis under the direction of Franca Sozzani. With 21 years she achieves the Moët&Chandon Young Fashion Award to the best young European designer. After working with Roberto Cavalli, Modesto Lomba and Pupi Solari she creates her own label, presenting her collections in Pasarela Gaudí, Milán and Mercedes-Benz Fashion Week Madrid where she has been participating since 2009.



MENCHÉN TOMÁS

After working separately for other labels they established their own brand in 1995, participating in Pasarela Gaudí until 2001. Currently they market their collections through their own points of sale and multibrand stores in Spain and abroad, accomplishing also couture models, made to measure.



MAYA HANSEN

Carried out her studies at the Centro Superior de Moda de Madrid. Wins the Porto Fashion Award in the year 2000 and presents her creations in Pasarela Gaudí, after being awarded the second price in the national contest, Young Designers by Smirnoff. Creates her own label in 2004 and two years later she specializes in the creation of corsets as outerwear. Presents her collections in Mercedes-Benz Fashion Week Madrid since 2011. Finalist in Vogue awards, Who's on Next 2012.
